 - × Reserve Status
 - Surplus Status (Evaluated annually cost vs. benefit)
 - × Projected replacement costs (3% annual increase)
 - Priority Assignments (wear and tear)

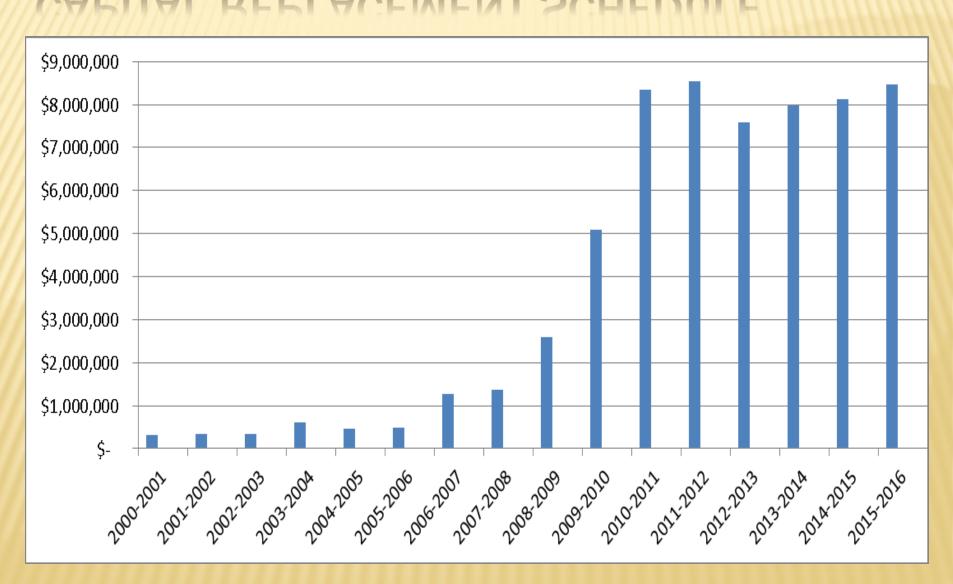

 - × History Lease Purchase Options
 - × "One Time" Purchases
 - Multiple Years Purchases (ongoing replacement)
 - × Construction Savings Plan
 - × Fluid Not "set in stone"
 - Vsed for budgeting, resource tracking
 - × IS NOT A FIXED ASSET INVENTORY

- Funding History
 - + Lease/ Purchase
 - + Roll over funds into Capital Reserve Account
 - + Maintenance and Operating Funds (Taxes)
 - + Exclusive Capital Funds Bonds
 - Need to return to a "balanced funding" Capital Reserve Funds and M&O Funds



- Transfers from the CYFD and CVFD total just over 9 million to CAFMA Capital Reserve Fund.
