B. Update Regarding Financial Statements

Chief Tharp explained that the Yavapai County Treasurer's office had a few glitches with the implementation of their new software; therefore, they have had a delay in issuing financial statements to all County agencies. He stated that staff is reviewing statements back to July and have found about \$180 in discrepancies. He anticipates having all financials from July through November at the December meeting. He is aware that we are out of compliance; however, that was out of our control. The auditors are waiting for the financials to finish the audit; therefore, the audit report will probably be delayed until January.
